



## GUSBOURNE GUINEVERE CHARDONNAY

Gusbourne has a strong claim to be the producer of the UK's highest quality wines, and is certainly one of the most widely awarded wineries in the country

They grow Chardonnay, Pinot
Noir and Pinot Meunier grapes
predominantly Burgundian
clones, across the Gusbourne
Estate, with 60 hectares in
Appledore, Kent and 30
hectares next to the
Goodwood Estate in West
Sussex. These clones yield
smaller volumes of intensely
flavourful fruit. The sparkling
wines are all made via the
traditional method and their

debut vintages – Brut Reserve 2006 and Blanc de Blancs 2006 – were released in 2010 to critical acclaim and today Gusbourne is the only threetime winner of the IWSC English Wine Producer of the Year.

Alongside superb fizz they make some of the UK's best still Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, which could pass for top quality Burgundy
