



## CARRAMIMBRE RESERVA 2016

£34.50

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Carramimbre, or 'wicker path' in ancient Spanish, is the name of one of the vineyards owned by Bodegas Pignon in the Ribera del Duero; situated at the bottom of a short hill, where an ancient castle still stands. Some of the vines here are as old as 50 years old.

The vineyards sit on the 'Golden Mile' of the Ribera del Duero (which is, in fact, 15km long) stretching along the Duero valley from the town of Peñafiel, down to Tudela de Duero. Here, the Bodegas rubs shoulders with many

neighbours (Alion, Vega Sicilia  
etc)

**Grape Varieties:** 95%  
Tempranillo, 5% Cabernet  
Sauvignon.

**Tasting Notes:** This is a wine  
with body, well structured,  
potent, tannic and long-lasting  
with a long finish which recalls  
notes of leather and roasts.  
This wine has good ageing  
potential.

**Sugar Level:** 1.0g/l

**Closure:** Natural Cork
