Le Vigneron Savoyard is small co-operative of vinegrowers in the mountainous cool climate Savoie region of Southeast France, which runs from Geneva into the French Alps. Founded in 1952 as the Chautagne Cooperative, in 2016, they merged with the Apremont Cooperative, allowing them to offer a wide range of wines from across the region, some of which are still vinified as single estate or domaine wines. These are fresh, distinct and extremely

food friendly wines, with moderate ABVs and clean, precise winemaking across the range

Domaine des Bartelettes is the estate of winegrower Gilles Clerc, who makes his wines using the facilities of the cave-co-op. This gorgeous mountain wine is made from the Altesse grape, grown on sandstone vineyards between Chambéry and Geneva. The wine is vinified in tank, with lees ageing and battonage to add texture and body. Creamy white peach and lemon rind flavours with a satin textured mid-palate and fine, mineral finish.
